DAY 1

To Grow in Relationship with God

God, thank you for loving me so much that you gave your only Son so that I might know you personally. Thank you for creating me for an intimate relationship with you. Help me to know you as I pray, spend time in Your Word and get to know others who share my faith. I want to know you like I know my close friends. You created me so you understand me. Help me to learn your ways and understand your love and your will for my life.

For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 NLT

DAY 2

To Pray

Sometimes I don't know how to talk to you, Lord. I don't know what to say. Help me to talk to you like I would a close friend. Teach me to pray for the things that you desire to see in my life. Search my heart and mind and reveal to me the truth of who I am and who you have created me to become. Give me the words to say and an understanding of how to hear your voice.
